# how to **be creative** this summer!

## Who gets a Summer Reading logbook?

Any child through 5th grade who is reading independently may sign up to be a summer reader and receive a logbook to track reading progress. Readers may complete as many logbooks as they want throughout the summer to be eligible for prizes. Sign up in the Children's Library or online at [www.faylib.org](http://www.faylib.org). Pre-readers and/or listeners also sign up in the library or online and get a listening logbook.

**For independent readers, how does the logbook work?** Readers will record time read. Thirty minutes equals one unit in the logbook. When 6 units (3 hours) in a logbook are completed, readers are eligible for stickers for each unit completed and a small prize for the first four logbooks. The first 100 who complete four logbooks will earn 2 tickets to the Northwest Arkansas Naturals baseball parade and game on Sunday, August 16. For every logbook completed, readers enter their name in the drawing for end-of-summer prizes to be announced on Wednesday, August 5, between the 1 pm and 2 pm elementary programs. All readers are eligible to receive a certificate of participation.

Certificates may be printed online or obtained from the Children's Desk.

The deadline for reporting logbooks is **5:00 pm, Monday, August 3.**

### What about the logbook for listeners?

Listeners or pre-readers may get a listening log at the Children's Desk. Parents and caregivers record the title of each book read to the child in the logbooks. For every six books, the child gets a sticker. When the logbook is filled, the child gets a small prize from the prize box. Listeners may fill as many logbooks as they want throughout the summer.

**Some children may be out of town for all or part of the summer. May they be part of the club and participate?** Yes, it is not necessary to be in town or in the library to participate. Be sure to bring your logbook and get your prizes when you visit the library.

**My grandchildren are visiting this summer. May they sign up?** Absolutely! You do not have to live in Fayetteville to participate.

**Does this club have meetings?** Each week throughout the summer, the library offers free events for all ages. Look for your age category in this calendar. Each event is educational and entertaining.

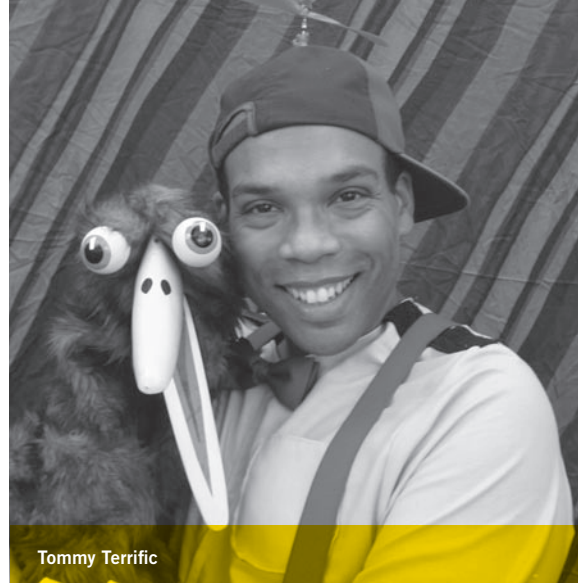

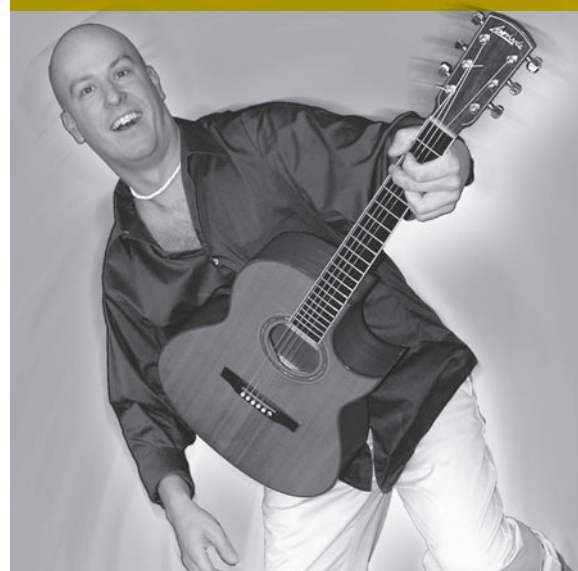
